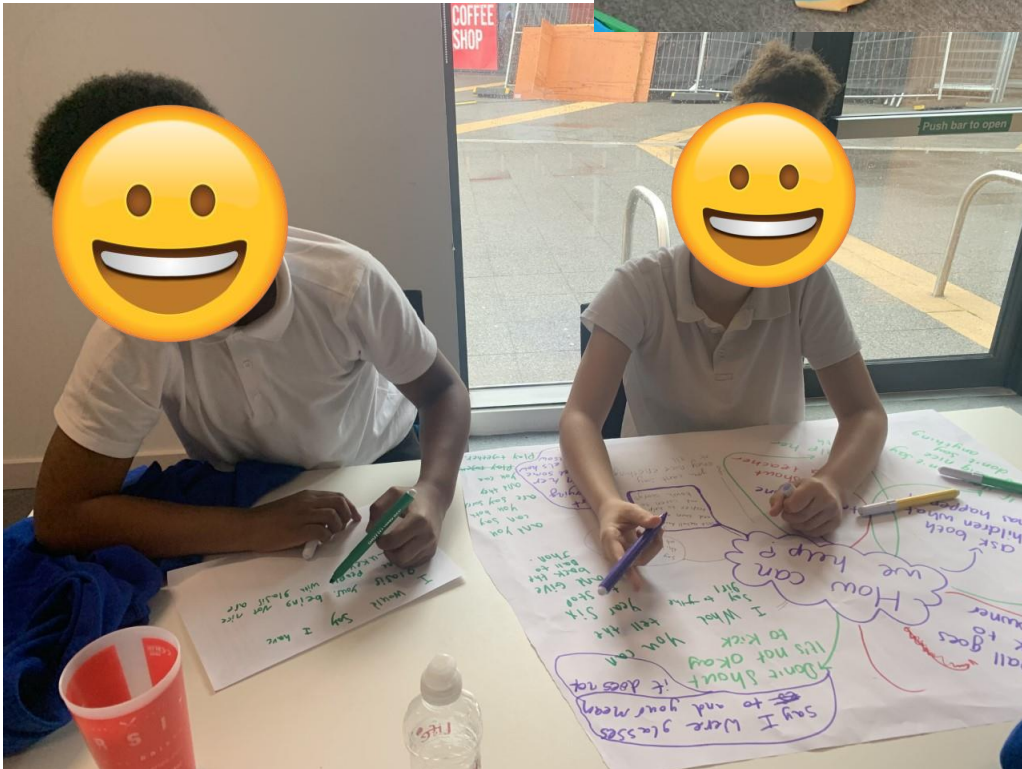
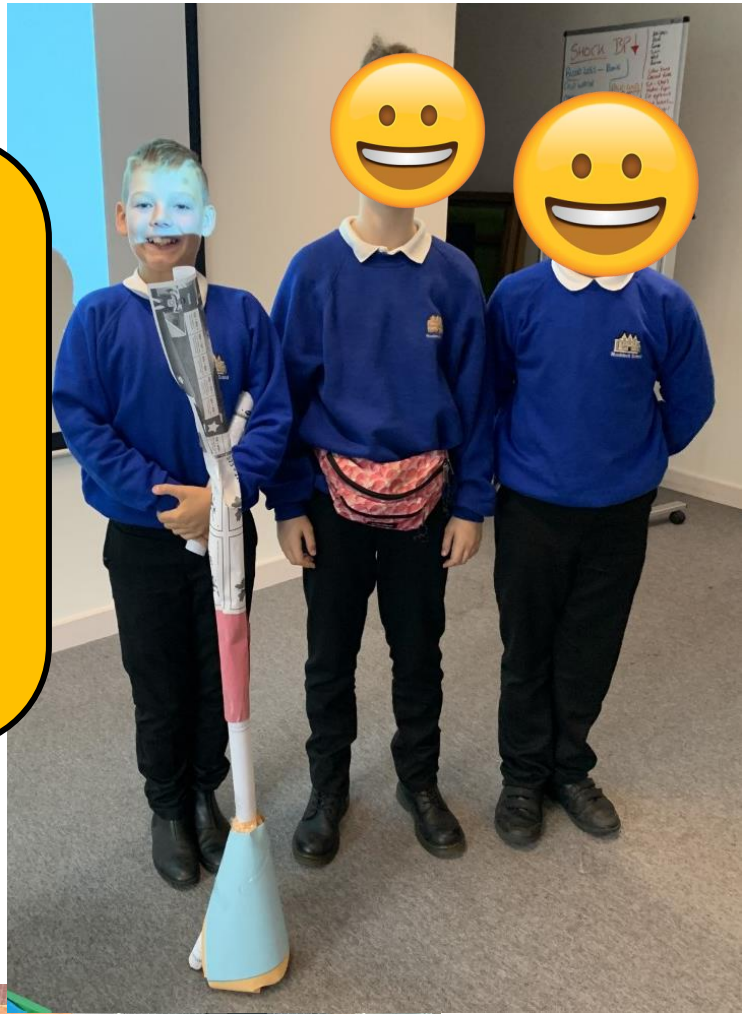
Woodstock School Anti-bullying Ambassador Training
